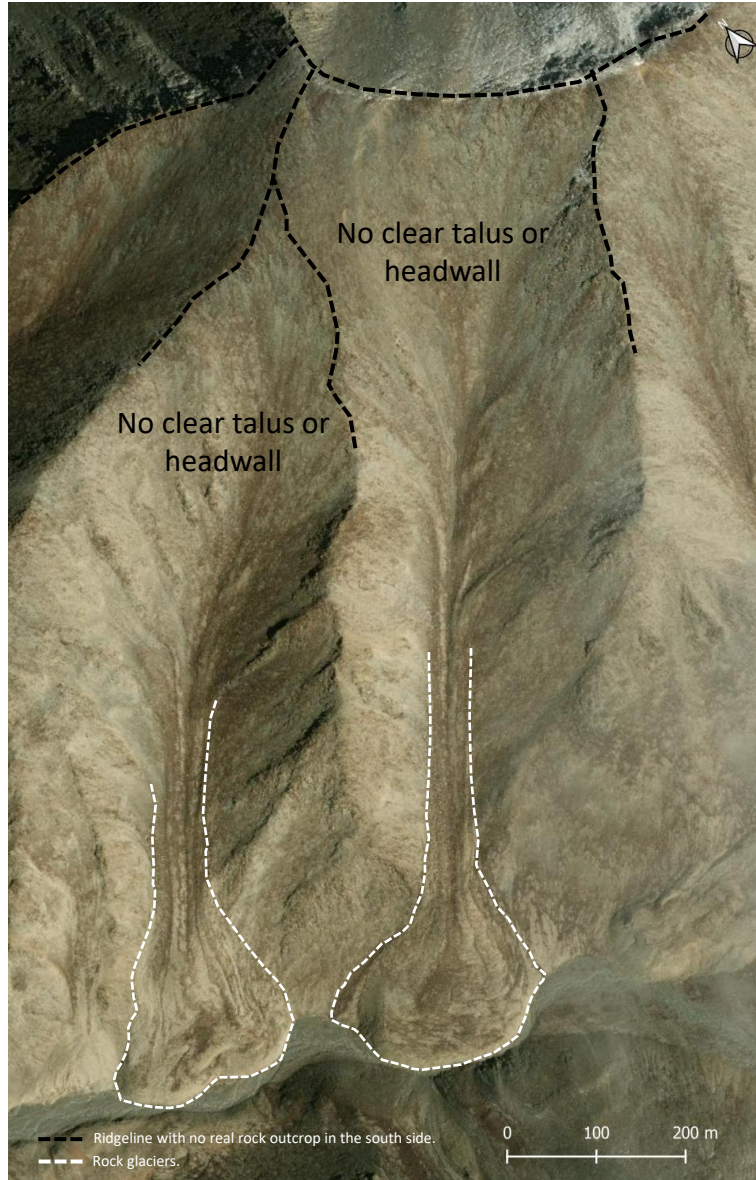


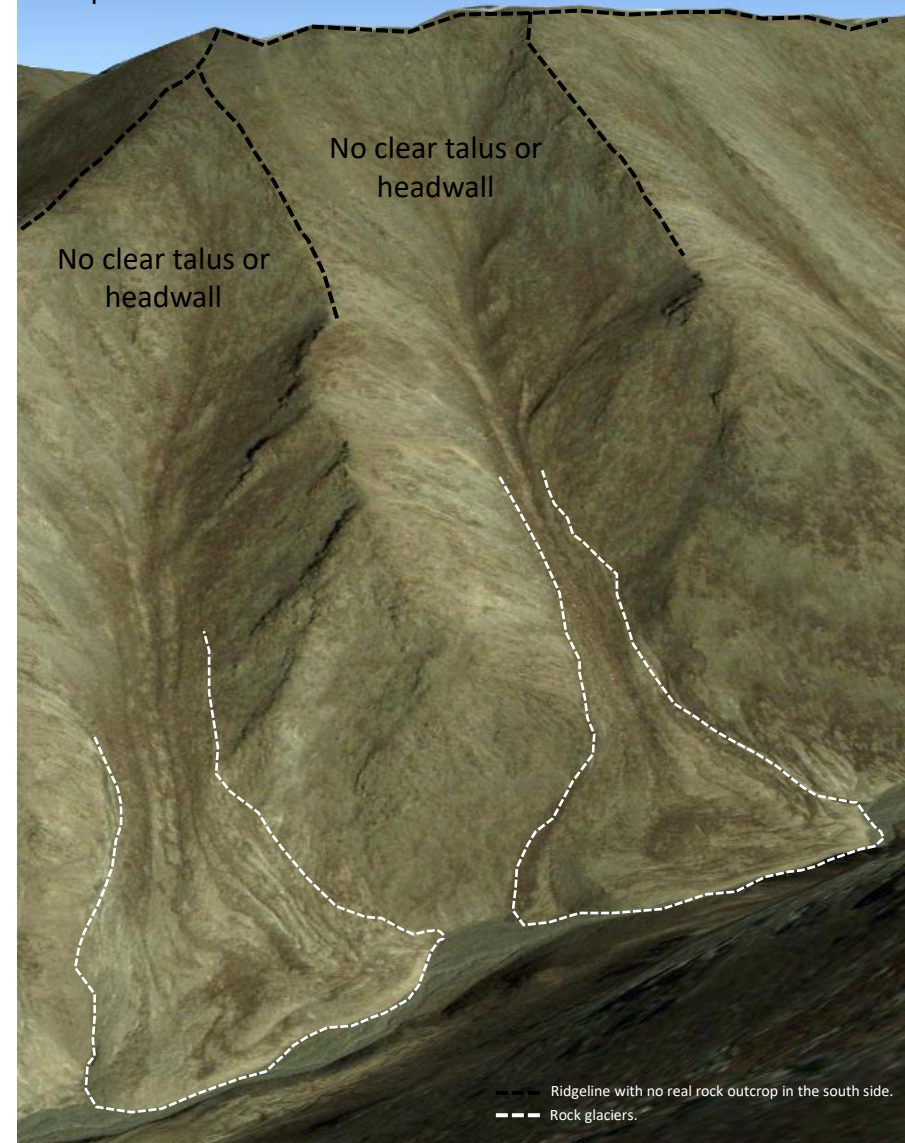
Spatial connection to the upslope unit / Debris-mantled slope-connected

Comment:

Rock glaciers are developing in almost every valley from sediments dominantly produced by in-situ bedrock weathering (debris mantle) in the upper slopes and gradually put into motion by shallow, surficial mass movement processes. There is a lack of a significant headwall.
