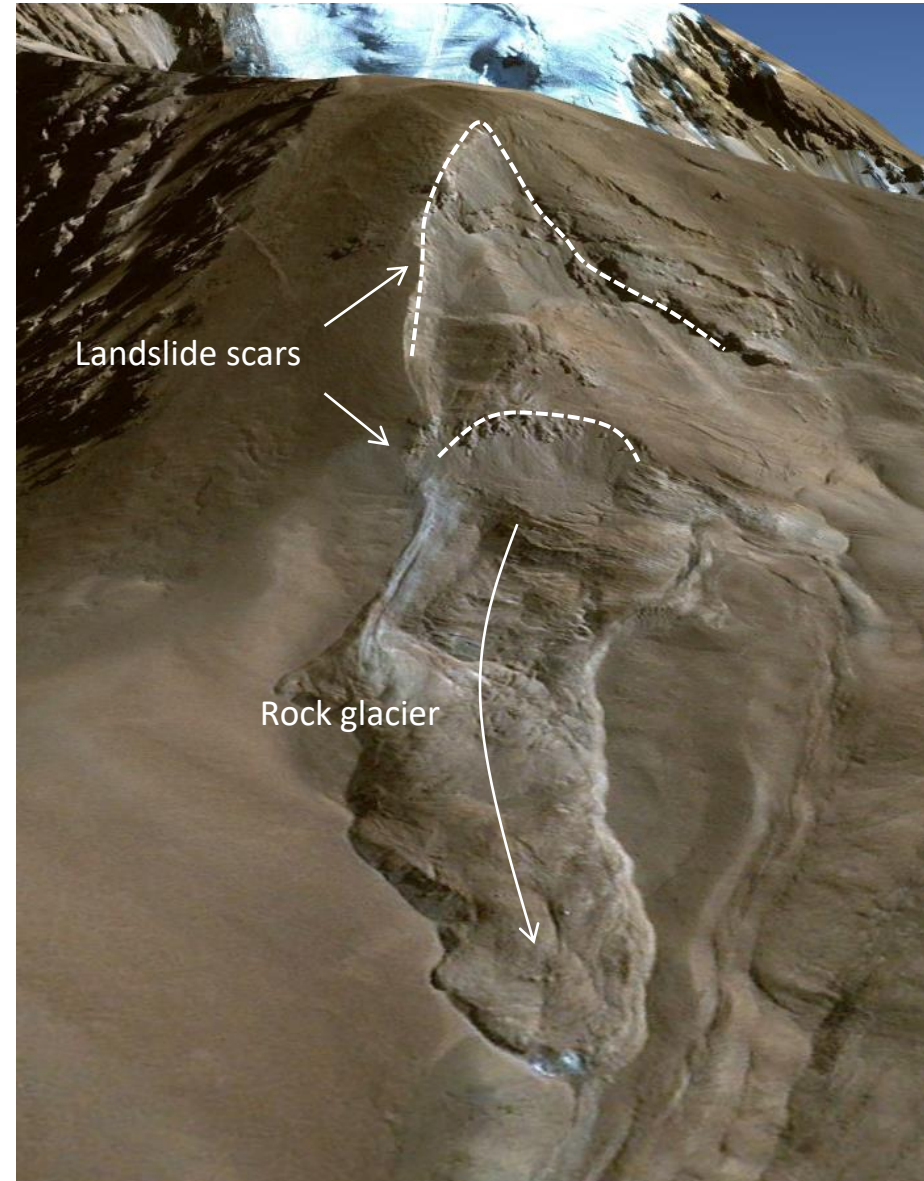


Spatial connection to the upslope unit / Landslide-connected

Comment:

The rock glaciers are located in direct downslope spatial connection to a landslide (i.e. rock or debris slide) in these two examples. The Gugla-B rock glacier has developed in about 20 years during the 1950-60s.
