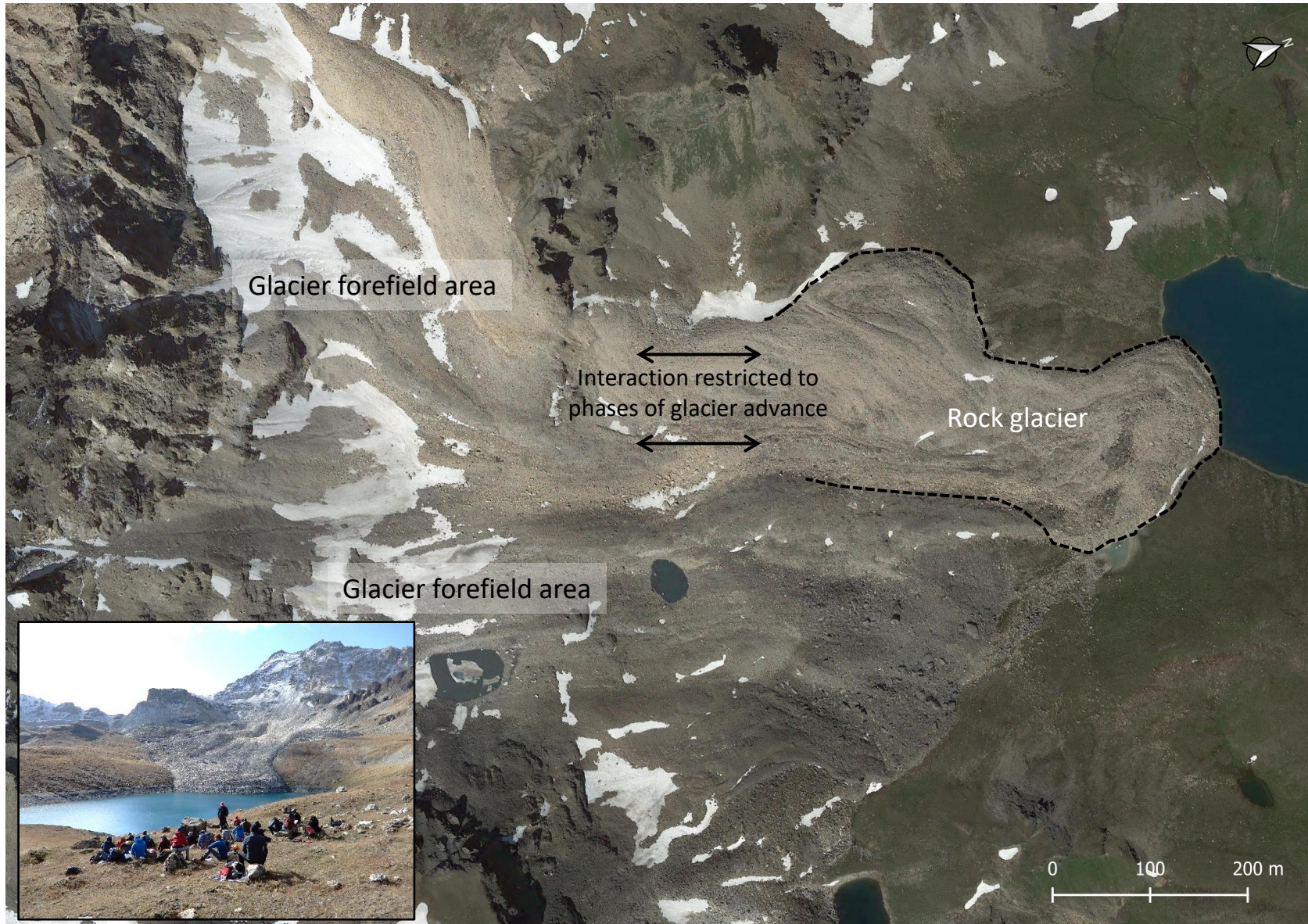


Spatial connection to the upslope unit / Glacier forefield-connected
