

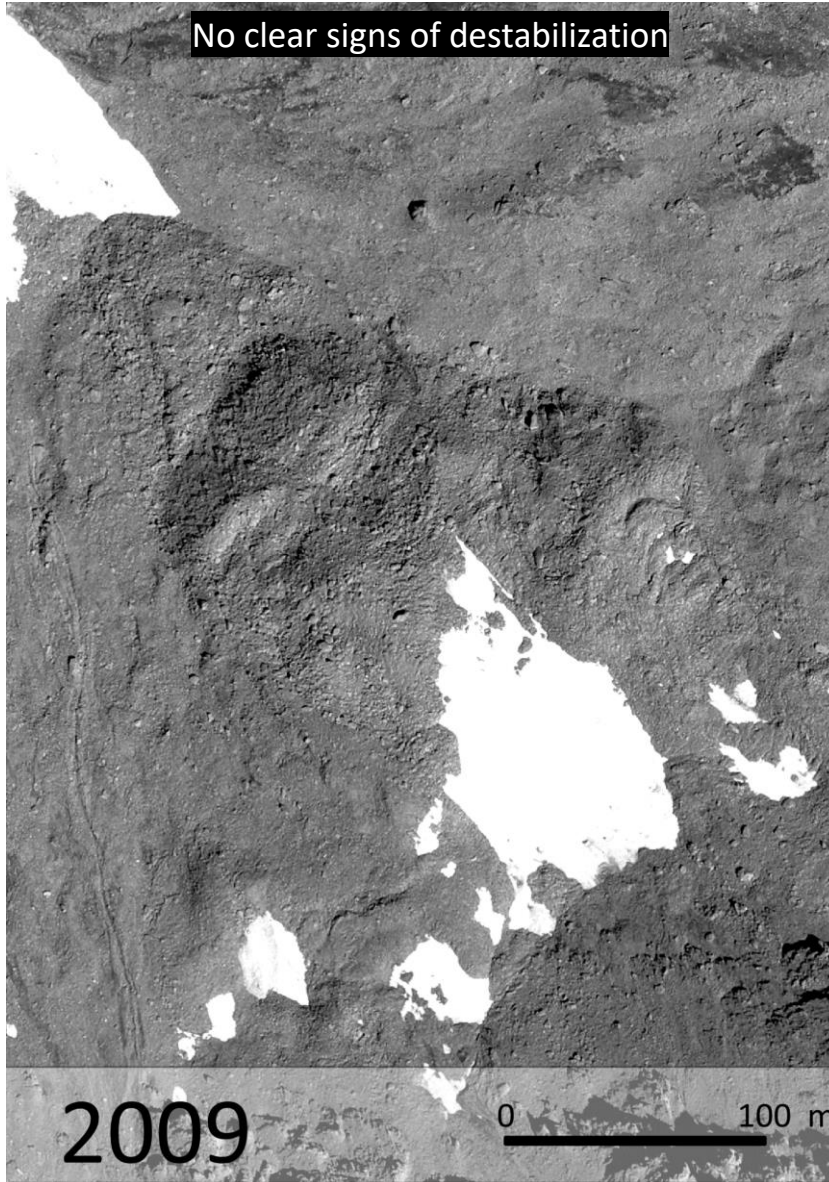
Rock glacier destabilization

Comment:

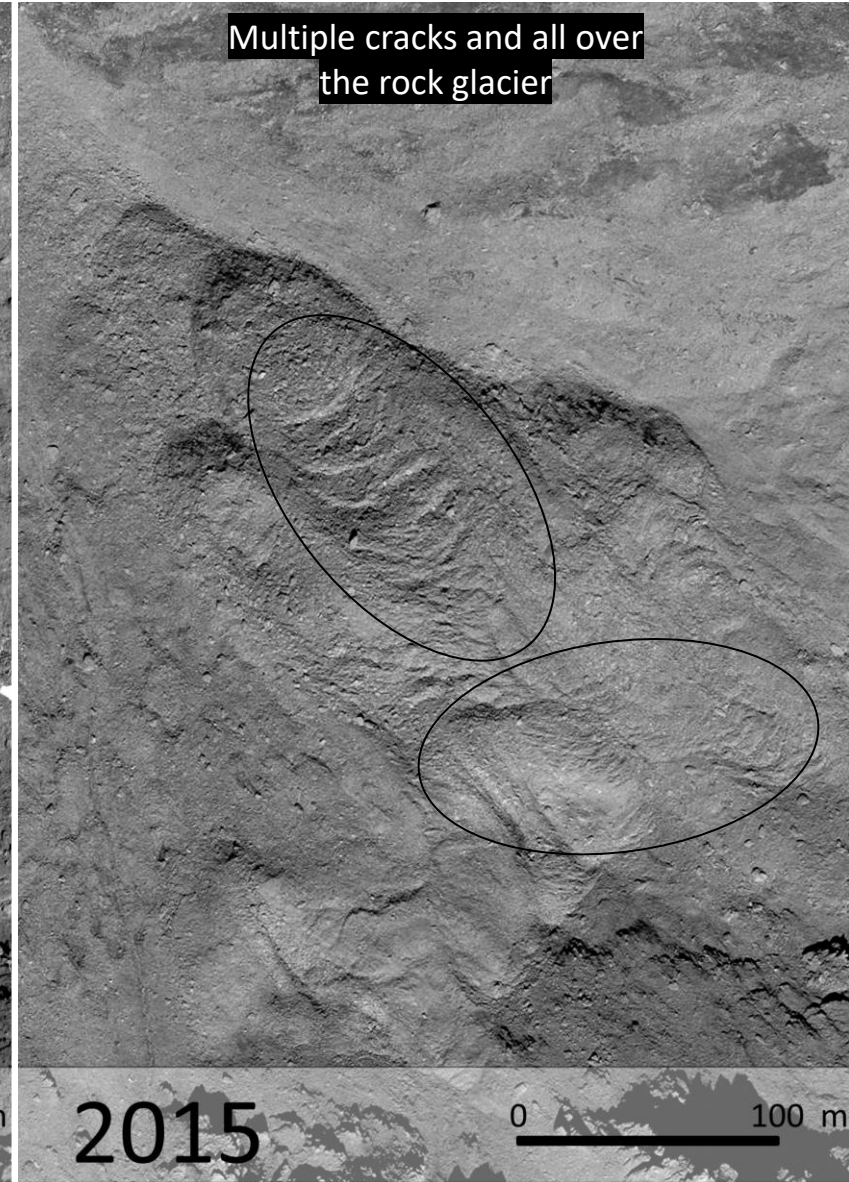
Development of multiple cracks and strong morphology changes indicating the ongoing destabilization of most of the rock glacier, except its very terminal part.

The destabilized section should be distinguished as a separate unit of the rock glacier system.
