

Complex rock glacier unit

Comment:

Complex rock glacier unit with multiple generations, multiple lobes of heterogeneous dynamics overlapping each other and the probable occurrence of a small glacier/ice patch in its uppermost part during the Little Ice Age.

Without kinematic data, there is mostly insufficient geomorphological evidence to unambiguously separate units.

This complex rock glacier unit is part of a larger multi-unit rock glacier system (9)
