

Spatial connection to the upslope unit / Talus-connected

Comment:

Two rock glacier mono-unit systems developing as end-members of the sequence headwall – talus slope (scree) – rock glacier.

In both cases, the concave (flatter) area in the uppermost section of the rock glacier has probably been occupied by a very small glacier or ice patch during the Little Ice Age. The rock glacier units are still classified as talus-connected.
