
Spatial connection to the upslope unit / Talus-connected

Comment:

Two rock glacier mono-unit systems developing as endmembers of the sequence headwall talus slope (scree) rock glacier. In both cases, the concave (flatter) area in the uppermost section of the rock glacier has probably been occupied by a very small glacier or ice patch during the Little Ice Age. The rock glacier units are still classified as talus-connected.
