Complex rock glacier unit | Mono-unit rock glacier system

Comment:

A single rock glacier unit of complex morphology can be discerned, building up a mono-unit rock glacier system. Without the use of kinematic data, there is no sufficient geomorphological evidence to unambiguously separate units. If so, however, the rock glacier system will become classified as multi-unit. Furthermore, delimiting between the debris-covered glacier part and the rock glacier unit is challenging.
